Waste Audit Workshop

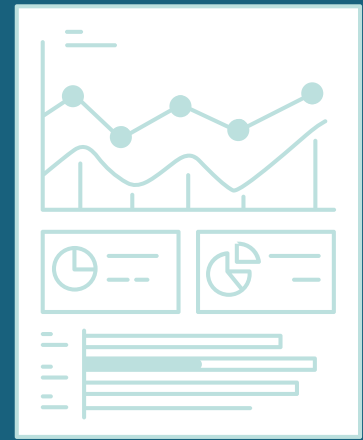


This 3-hour educational workshop with up to 30 selected learners is an investigation into how much waste is generated at the school: from traditional waste, recyclables and compost, to e-waste. It is the first step to becoming a zero-waste school.



This workshop & audit allows learners to:

-  Understand the percentage breakdown and weight of various waste materials in the schools' bins on an average week.
-  Gain insight into the patterns of waste disposed of at the school (i.e., where the most waste is thrown away, where food waste is mostly generated, etc).
-  Identify and observe weak points in the waste system and develop specific solutions to the identified issues.
-  Distinguish recyclable vs non-recyclable waste and what food waste can be composted.
-  Develop broad ideas and solutions to make the schools waste system more effective.



Report for Management

Our team uses all the information gathered during the audit workshop to compile an audit report. It includes the necessary data and insights to help you understand your current school waste system as a whole and identify opportunities for recycling and managing food waste.

The Proposal

From the audit report we develop a proposal for school management which details how to create a sustainable and effective recycling and food waste management system and culture at your school. It details:

-  Customised recycling and food waste bin infrastructure setup and system.
-  Specified training and education workshops for school teachers and leadership, grounds/cleaning staff, learners and more.
